A lacquer plaque depicting St. Petersburg on the river Neva. At the reverse with inscription: “Vue Perspective des Bords de la Neva en descendant la Rivière entre le Palais d’hyver de sa Majesté Impériale et les batiments de l’Académie des Sciences à St Petersburg”. Black lacquer on copper, decorated and inscribed in gold and inlaid with mother of pearl at the reverse.

An identical plaque is in the Museum of Japanese History in Sakura and another one in the Museum of Peter the Great in St Petersburg, a present by the Swedish medical doctor Johan Arnold Stutzer, who served with the VOC in Deshima in 1787-1788, to Catherine the Great in 1794. Japan, Nagasaki, circa 1788. 23 cm. by 39 cm.

Indian carved ebony and ivory inlaid armchair, in the crest rail the coat of arms of the Irish FitzGerald family of the Knights of Glin. The last Knight of Glin was Desmond John Villiers FitzGerald (1937-2011), the 29th Knight of Glin. President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, through his mother Rose Elisabeth FitzGerald (1890-1995), is a descendant of the FitzGerald lineage. Coromandel Coast/Madras, late 17th century.
